



Why Bangladesh is Lucrative for Investment?

- Japan government included Bangladesh in subsidy destination list to diversify supply chain
- Companies may take incentives facilities for relocating investment
- Bangladesh among Top 20
 Promising Courtiers for last 3
 consecutive years for Business by
 JBIC Survey 2022
- 71.6% Japanese companies in Bangladesh plan to expand for 2023 and 2024 (JETRO 2022)
- Bangladesh and Japan working together for possible Economic Partnership


