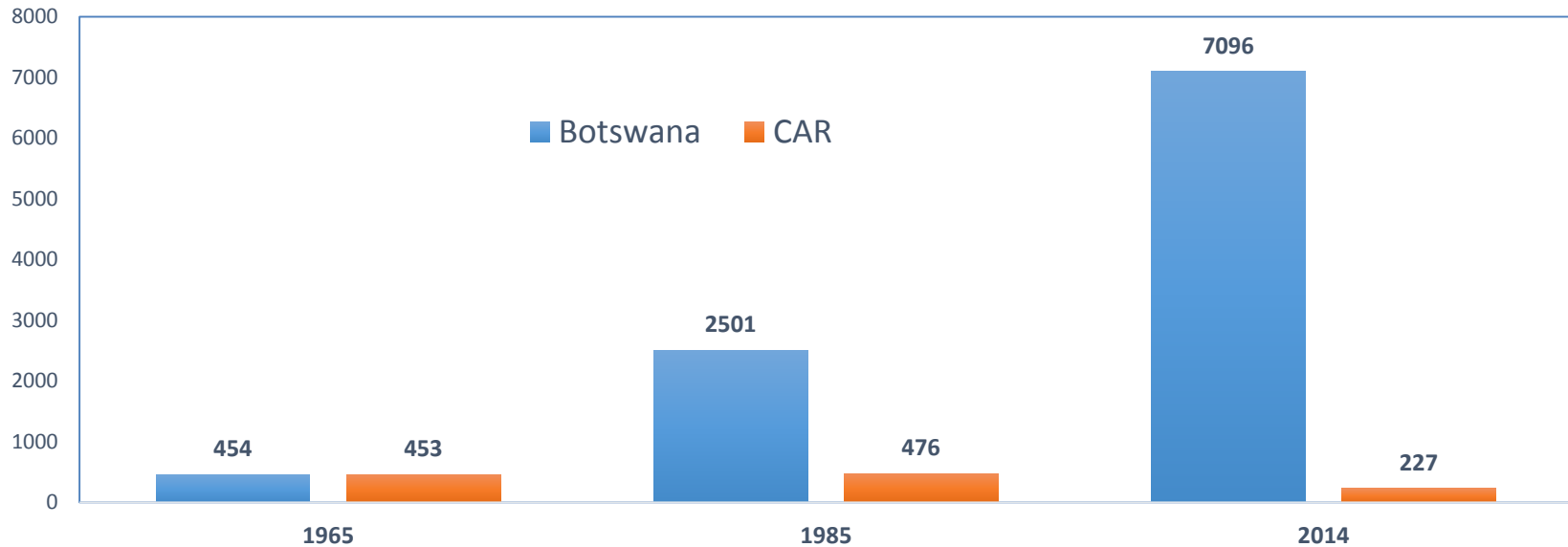

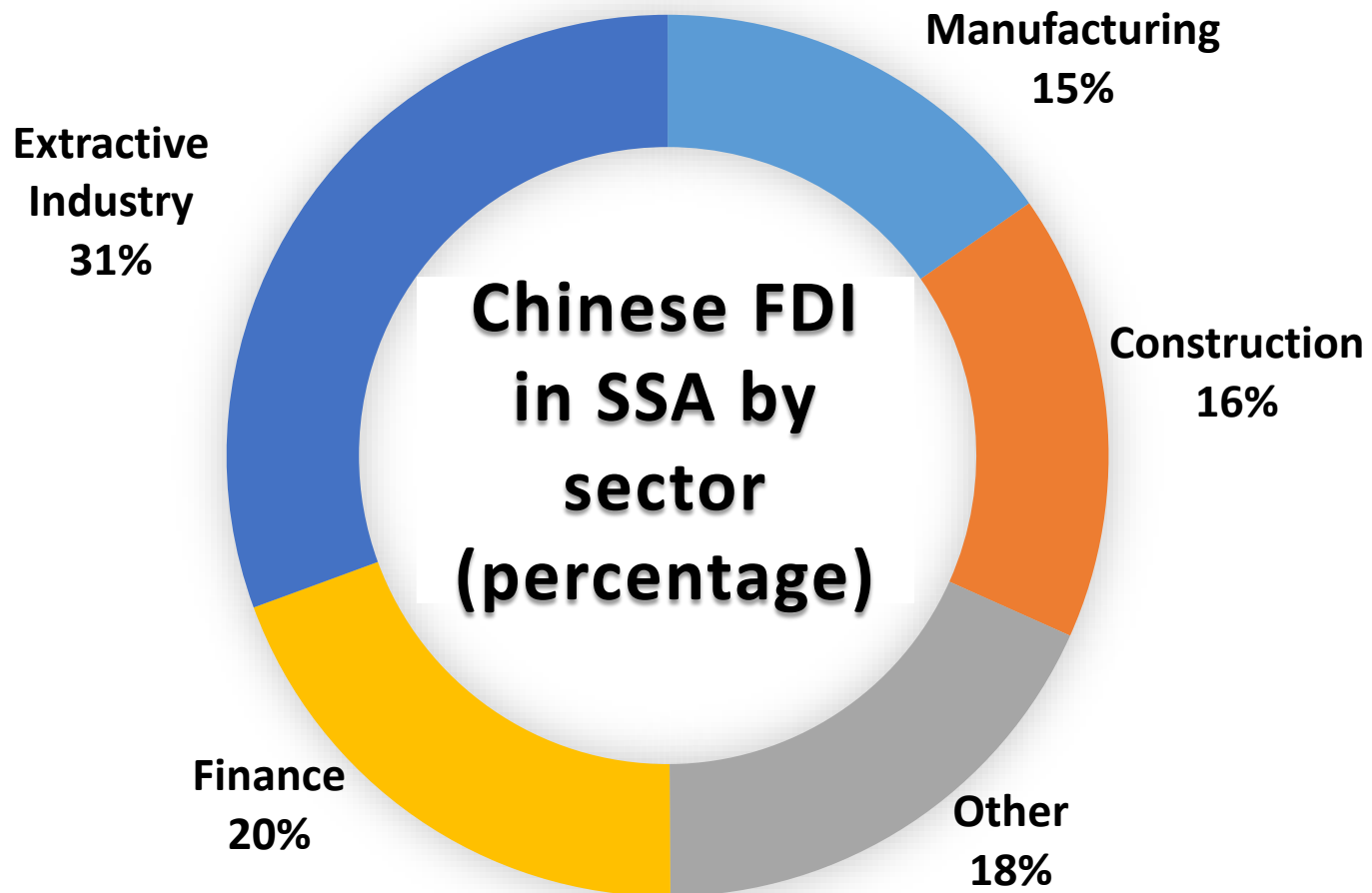
Africa and emerging economies: China (1)
