The "Conseil Patronal des Energies Renewables du Senegal" (COPERES) was founded by the first International Conference "Environment and Energy Independence » Public-Private Partnership and Civil Society, to meet the challenge of Development and Promotion of Renewable Energy in Africa » organized by TENERGIE and the Club de Convergences Plurielles in partnership with ENDA and the private renewable energy sector of Senegal, hold from October 5 to 6, 2015 at the King Fahd Palace Hotel in Dakar, Senegal.

The association comes from the National Associations of Renewable Energy Professionals which brings together entrepreneurs under Senegalese law, independent producers, installers, rural concession managers, consultants and other private services under Senegalese renewable energy law.

COPERES is also a member of the ECOWAS Professional Association of Renewable Energy (APER-ECOWAS).
