# The Project for Promoting Youth Employment Through Automotive Maintenance Skills Training

### Output 1. DEVELOPING COMPETENCY-BASED AND DEMAND DRIVEN CURRICULUM



Two technical workshops will be held at The National Council for Technical, Vocational and Other Academic Awards (NCTVA) on the 5<sup>th</sup>, 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup>, 13<sup>th</sup> and 14<sup>th</sup> of September for the development of National Automotive Curriculum. All arrangements for the workshops are finalized and two international experts will be joining the workshop along with the national stakeholders in charge of curriculum development.

### Output 2. ESTABLISHING A CENTER OF EXCELLENCE FOR AUTOMOTIVE TECHNICIAN TRAINING



Four automotive experts from the Government Technical Institute (GTI) Kissy successfully completed a one week Training of Trainers (ToT) course on “Vehicle Safety, Measuring and Hydraulic Breaking System” Training at CICA Motors (SL) Ltd., Toyota official distributor in Sierra Leone.



A six-weeks ToT is ongoing at the West African Vehicle Academy (WAVA) in Accra, Ghana. The four automotive experts from GTI already completed two trainings “Vehicle Dynamics” and “Diesel Injection” in the first two weeks, four more trainings are planned at WAVA, which will end on the 29<sup>th</sup> of September 2023.



All logistical arrangements have been set for the four automotive experts from GTI Kissy to attend a four weeks ToT at Toyota Kenya Academy in Nairobi, Kenya starting 9<sup>th</sup> of October 2023.
