

## TICAD V UNIDO-AU Side Event:

### **Clean Technologies for Sustainable Industrial Development of Africa: *resource efficiency and renewable energy for low carbon and climate resilient growth***

#### **Purpose**

The United Nations Industrial Development Organization (UNIDO) and the African Union (AU) have enjoyed a long-lasting cooperative relationship fostered by a mutual recognition of the need for sustainable development and inclusive growth in the African region. One fundamental aspect of achieving sustainable development in the region is the use of clean technologies to improve resource productivity in enterprises as an engine for income and employment creation. In this regard, UNIDO has many ongoing and past activities within the region that facilitate access to and deployment of cleaner technologies and start the transition to low carbon and climate resilient patterns of growth. Some examples include promoting renewable energy for productive uses in rural areas, waste-to-energy application in agro-industries, cleaner production and energy access for poverty alleviation.
