PROJECT SUMMARY

The SAP 200069 project aims to close skills gaps in Zambia's construction and mining industries, supporting the country's Eighth National Development Plan. This will be achieved through:

- Developing a competency-based, demand-driven modern curriculum for construction equipment operators.
- Establishing a regional centre of excellence for construction equipment operator training.
- Providing vocational training and career services focused on unemployed, underemployed, female and disadvantaged youth.

This project builds on United Nations Industrial Development Organization's (UNIDO) experience in Technical and Vocational Education and Training, particularly Public-Private Development Partnerships. The partnership between the Governments of Japan and Zambia, Hitachi Construction Machinery (HCM), and UNIDO will stimulate systemic change to address skills gaps.

The KVTC project seeks to provide employment opportunities for youth by training them as qualified, skilled heavy equipment operators to meet construction and mining sector demand.











AIM

In alignment with project activity 3.3, the initiation of a career service center at Kitwe Vocational Training Centre (KVTC) necessitates a strong engagement with the industry to foster synergies and explore the possibility of establishing a Memorandum of Understanding. Such an agreement would enable students to participate in attachments, internships, industrial tours, and apprenticeships, enhancing their training experience.

Bellview Group of Companies visited KVTC for a knowledge sharing session on 24th July , 2023. The primary objective of this visit was to promote KVTC's Heavy Equipment Operator (HEO) training and various courses offered at KVTC .

The aim was to establish a mutually beneficial partnership between KVTC, as a skills training institution, and Bellview Group of Companies, as a government organization responsible for regulating, streamlining, and enhancing capacity within the construction industry.

Bellview is also a prominent stakeholder in the construction industry and qualified auditing and testing of equipment and machinery .



Mr. Osward Kabwesha took time to show the guests the latest excavator meant for HEO courses .






